Therefore, a thesis statement in an analysis paper should be answering a HOW or WHY question. A strong thesis makes a claim about the subject that needs proving. It provides the writer (and the reader) with a clearly focused lens through which to view the subject.

Analytical Thesis Statements - University of Arizona Identify analytical thesis statements. In order to write an analysis, you want to first have a solid understanding of the thing you are analyzing. Remember, this means: Breaking down information or artifacts into component parts. Uncovering relationships among those parts. Determining motives, causes, and underlying assumptions.
