Mills identified “ troubles ” (personal challenges) and “ issues ” (larger social challenges), also known as biography, and history, respectively. Mills ’ sociological imagination allows individuals to see the relationships between events in their personal lives (biography), and events in their society (history).

The Sociological Imagination is a 1959 book by American sociologist C. Wright Mills published by Oxford University Press. In it, he develops the idea of sociological imagination, the means by which the relation between self and society can be understood. Mills felt that the central task for sociology and sociologists was to find the connections between the particular social environments of individuals and the wider social and historical forces in which they are enmeshed. Wright Mills defined the sociological imagination as "the vivid awareness of the relationship between personal experience and the wider society" (1959:6). It enables us to "grasp history and biography and the relations between the two within society" (1959:6). In other words, it is the ability to understand how personal experiences are shaped by historically-conditioned social forces.

Sociological Imagination

The sociological imagination defines visionaries who can see beyond what is in front of them in relation to history, biography and social structure. (Mills, 1959, pg. 7) The theory of the sociological imagination facilitates an individual to associate their own life experience with the whole of history along with social, economic, and political forces.
