Magnificent Frigatebird is the only member of its family regularly seen in mainland Ecuador. It plucks food items from the water's surface or steals prey from other seabirds. Pelicans are robust coastal seabirds known for their characteristic long, hooked bill with ample gular pouch, used for collecting fish.

This is a list of the bird species recorded in Ecuador including those of the Galapagos Islands.The avifauna of Ecuador has 1639 confirmed species, of which seven are endemic to the mainland and 30 are endemic to the Galapagos. Four have been introduced by humans, 65 are rare or vagrants, and two have been extirpated.An additional 47 species are hypothetical (see below).

Even the rarest and most difficult birds are presented in full-color, high-resolution photographs, such as the Banded Ground-Cuckoo, Black-Chested Puffleg, Rufous-Crowned Antpitta, Star-Chested Treerunner, Choco Vireo, Golden-Chested Tanager, and Tanager Finch.

The book is lighter and not as unwieldy in the field as The Birds of Ecuador (2001; Ridgely and Greenfield), though, granted, covers only western Ecuador and not entire country, and includes much more information than Fieldbook of the Birds of Ecuador (2013; McMullan and Navarrete), though the latter is very lightweight and can easily slide into a daypack pocket.
