*General Rule: Consent of a minor to medical care or treatment is ineffective. A physician must secure the consent of the minor's custodial parent or a person standing in loco parentis. **Consent For The General Minor Procedures Necessary To The**  
Section 23 of The Non-Fatal Offences Against the Persons Act 1997 provides for minors aged 16 or 17 to consent to surgical, medical or dental treatment. Generally speaking, parental consent is needed for all other minors, and for 16 and 17 year olds who lack capacity, but there may be circumstances in which a person under the age of 16 who demonstrates the maturity to understand the implications of a particular treatment does not wish his or her parents to be involved in that decision.

**Who can consent on behalf of a minor**  
Consent and minors. We should now focus on two important aspects relating to the issue of consent and the position of minors from the perspective of the GDPR. According to Article 6 (1) (a) of the GDPR, the processing of personal data is considered lawful if data subjects provide their consent to this processing for one or more specific purposes. Thus, if the consent of data subjects is obtained, controllers and processors may process personal data of individuals.

Children and young people. People aged 16 or over are entitled to consent to their own treatment. This can only be overruled in exceptional circumstances. Like adults, young people (aged 16 or 17) are presumed to have sufficient capacity to decide on their own medical treatment, unless there's significant evidence to suggest otherwise. Children under the age of 16 can consent to their own treatment if they're believed to have enough intelligence, competence and understanding to fully ...

Consent: patients and doctors making decisions together The duties of a doctor registered with the General Medical Council Patients must be able to trust doctors with their lives and health. To justify that trust you must show respect for human life and make sure your practice meets the standards expected of you in four domains.

**Consent: patients and doctors making decisions together**  
When we refer to a child we mean anyone under the age of 18. This is in accordance with the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child which defines a child as everyone under 18 unless, "under the law applicable to the child, majority is attained earlier" (Office of the High Commissioner for Human Rights, 1989). The UK has ratified this convention.

**Consent Policy - GOV.UK**  
Under the Minors' Consent Act, a parent may consent to voluntary inpatient treatment (pursuant to the MHPA) of a minor who is 17 years old or younger, provided that a physician who examined the minor recommended the treatment. 18 The consent is for voluntary treatment even if the minor does not consent because, in that scenario, the parent alone has the power to consent.
