Step 1: Prepare the new drum brake. Many drums will become coated in a thin oily film to prevent them from rusting during shipping and storage. If that is the case, be sure to liberally spray the drums with brake cleaner to remove any of the film that may be present before installing them. Step 2: Install the drum brake over the brake shoes. Once the drum is clean and ready to install, slip it over the brake shoes and install it onto the hub.

1. Replace the brake spider(s) as determined in the inspection. 2. Reinstall all of the remaining components of the brake assembly, including shoes and drums, in accordance with the normal service protocols outlined in Bendix service manual BW7258. Ensure all hardware is installed

Slide the new or resurfaced drum over the wheel studs. Install lock screws in drum if equipped. Adjust the brakes through the drum or through the backing plate till a slight drag on the brake drum is felt. Reinstall the tire. Check brake adjustment and readjust as needed to have a slight drag on the drum.
