Under lateral fluoroscopic guidance, the atlantoaxial subluxation is gently reduced, and the head is fixed in place. A conventional midline occiput to C3 exposure is performed so that the C1 and C2 lateral masses and the C1–C2 and C2–C3 facet joints are revealed. The DRA is attached to the C2 spinous process.

Fluoroscopy-guided lumbar puncture (LP) is a minimally invasive, image-guided diagnostic and therapeutic procedure that involves the removal of a small volume of cerebrospinal fluid (CSF) from, or an injection of medication or other substance (e.g. radiotracer, chemotherapy agents) into the lumbar cistern of the spinal column. In addition to improving success rates, fluoroscopic guidance may reduce the incidence of a so-called traumatic LP.

Position the patient in a basic supine position so that the bottom of the c-arm can go under the table below the knee. Bend the knees roughly 90 degrees and put a roll under it so the patient ' s legs can stay relaxed. This opens up the joint space a bit. Having someone help hold the patient ' s foot can be helpful.
