1.1 How to form Questions in the Present Simple A question must have an auxiliary verb. If you have an auxiliary in the sentence you must use the same one in the question. If you don't have an auxiliary verb in the sentence, add the auxiliary verb 'to do'.

To make questions, we often put the verb before the subject. This is called inversion. If there is a question word (why, what, where, how, etc.), it goes before the verb. This is true for sentences with be, sentences that have auxiliary verbs (e.g.

Question forming is often difficult for foreign language speakers due to the mandatory word order inversion in English questions. This is especially true for Spanish speaking students, where word order inversion is uncommon. In each question, students are presented with a group of words. The object is to put these words in the correct order to form a syntactically correct question.
