George Eumorfopoulos Collection
Collection. Eumorfopoulos had intended to bequeath his collection to the British nation, but the Great Depression of the 1930s forced him to sell part of it, in what was called 'a princely gesture', to the Victoria & Albert and British Museums for £100 000 in 1934/5; he also sold some duplicates through Bluett's, the London art dealers, and between 1927 and 1936 donated 800 pieces to the Benaki Museum, Athens.

Bonhams—A complete set of the George Eumorfopoulos—: A final sale was held in 1944 after the death of his widow Julia Eumorfopoulos (q.v.). R.L.Hobson wrote an eleven volume catalogue on his collections, simply entitled 'The George Eumorfopoulos Collection' (London: Ernest Benn, 1925-32). George Eumorfopoulos was the first president of the Oriental Ceramic Society (1921-1939), a member of the Burlington Fine Arts Club and the Royal Asiatic Society, a fellow of the Society of Antiquaries and a benefactor of the Egypt Exploration Society.

His collection forms the basis of holdings in this area at the V&A and the British Museum. G.F Watts was one of the leading portrait painters of the Victorian era. The portrait of Eumorfopoulos was painted at the end of Watts' life.

209-Horses (pair of finials)—The George Ortiz Collection
A large number of Chinese antiquities were purchased from the Anglo-Greek banker George Eumorfopoulos in the 1930s. The large collection of some 1800 Japanese prints and paintings owned by Arthur Morrison was acquired in the early twentieth century.

A famous collector of modern and oriental art, George Eumorfopoulos, encouraged the exhibition of her work in London, which led to an exhibition in Berlin. There the seeds of a likely commission from the British government in Malaysia were sown.

Dorich House—a modernist joy in south-west London—: The Chinese collection was greatly enhanced in the 20th century by the 1935 acquisition of the vast George Eumorfopoulos collection, rich in paintings, ceramics, ivory, lacquer and jade objects. Split between the British Museum and the V&A, private donors helped fund the purchase including Sir Percival David.
