USING PYTHAGORAS THEOREM - SOME CHALLENGING QUESTIONS

If we take the length of the hypotenuse to be c and the length of the legs to be a and b then this theorem tells us that: $c^2 = a^2 + b^2$. Pythagorean Theorem states that. In any right triangle, the sum of the squared lengths of the two legs is equal to the squared length of the hypotenuse.

Pythagorean Theorem (solutions, examples, answers)

A short equation, Pythagorean Theorem can be written in the following manner: $a^2+b^2=c^2$. In Pythagorean Theorem, c is the triangle's longest side while b and a make up the other two sides. The longest side of the triangle in the Pythagorean Theorem is referred to as the 'hypotenuse'. Many people ask why Pythagorean Theorem is important.

We know the length of two sides of the triangle and to determine the length of the hypotenuse, we just have to insert the lengths we know into the equation. $c^2 = a^2 + b^2$. $c^2 = 9^2 + 10^2$. $c^2 = 81 + 100$. $c^2 = 181$. $c = 13.5$ cm. We see now that the missing length of the hypotenuse is 13.5 cm and that is our result.
