First Registration. Obtaining historical copies of the Land Registry Title Register can be carried out online going backwards from today to the date of First Registration. This is the date upon which the property first became registered. Before this date the Land Registry would not be aware of the existence of the property and therefore there would not be a Title Register or Title Plan for the property prior to this date.
