Cold, Dark Spores - cold, dark colours like dark chocolate, grey or black, often with a tinge of purple. Pale Spores - for yellow to orange spores, first try Russula or (if it bleeds), Lactarius. For pale pink, start with Rhodocollybia or Macrocyttidia. For free gills, try Amanitaceae and Lepiota first.

Psilocybe fimetaria is a magic mushroom known to grow in Great Britain. Its cap is 1.5cm to 3.5cm in diameter and is usually broadly convex with translucent striations on the surface. When moist, the cap becomes sticky and reddish brown to honey. When dried, it becomes yellowish olive to ochre.
