#### How to Repair Damaged Wallpaper (DIY)

No matter where the loose seam is or what caused it, the repair procedure is the same: Dip a small artist's brush into wallpaper-seam adhesive (about \$3 for a 4-oz. tube at paint and wallcovering stores). Spread an even coat of adhesive onto the underside of the exposed seam (photo 1). Then use a wooden seam roller to flatten the seam (photo 2).

Painted wallpaper will usually repel water, so scoring is key to aid penetration. Use the tool to score evenly and consistently over the wallpaper without damaging the plaster underneath. You don't need to press too hard, just enough to allow the teeth to cut into the surface of the paper. Don't use a knife or scissors to perforate the paper ...

Paint a thin layer of seam adhesive on the back of the wallpaper. Don't apply the adhesive to the wall or it won't stick as well. Use a small paintbrush to evenly coat the underside of the peeling piece. You can buy wallpaper seam adhesive from a hardware store or an online retailer.

If the wallpaper cannot be peeled from the wall, you will need to work a bit harder. First, use a wallpaper scoring tool to ensure your wallpaper stripping solution can properly soak the paper. Then create a solution using a mixture of hot water and wallpaper stripper as advised on the packaging. Alternatively, you can make a 1:1 solution of hot water and unscented fabric softener to soak the walls.
