What Does "washed in the Blood of the Lamb" Mean in the Bible? Well " washed-rind cheese " does exactly what it says on the tin: the rind of the cheese is washed during the maturing process. During this maturation, the outside of the cheese is moistened (washed) gently with a damp cloth or brush, sometimes regularly, sometimes only once or twice.

Answer: When the Bible speaks of our sins being washed away, it means we are forgiven. Our sins, which had defiled us, are gone. By the grace of God through Christ, we are no longer spiritually corrupt; we stand justified before God. The concept of having our sins washed away is first introduced in the Old Testament.

What does it mean that our sins are washed away ... Answer: Jesus washing the feet of the disciples (John 13:1-17) occurred in the upper room, during the Last Supper and has significance in three ways. For Jesus, it was the display of His humility and His servanthood. For the disciples, the washing of their feet was in direct contrast to their heart attitudes at that time.
